Make an apple birdfeeder

You will need:

an apple
a corer
sunflower seeds
3 sticks
string

- 1 Remove the core from the apple, preferable using a corer.
- 2 Push the sunflower seeds into the top half of the apple for the birds to eat.
- 3 Make bird perches by pushing one stick into either side of the apple, but near the bottom.
- 4 Tie the string round the last stick and thread the string through the core of the apple
- 5 The apple should sit on the stick and you will be able to tie the apple onto the branch of a tree in your garden.

Can you name all the birds feeding on your apple?
