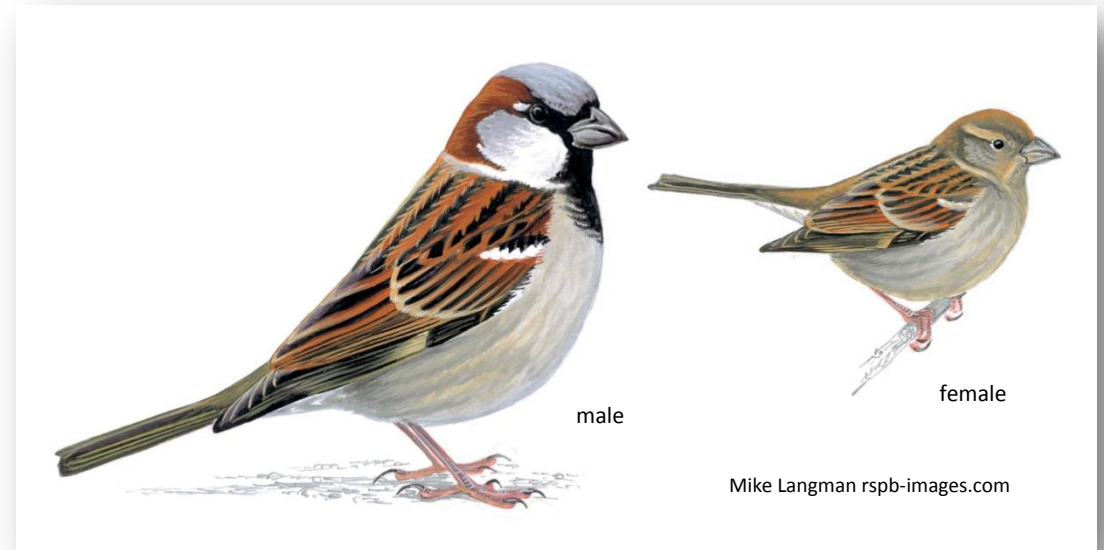




RSPB Cockney Sparrow Count
