

## RSPB Mid-Nene Local Group 2021 Calendar Photography Competition rules

The theme for Mid-Nene Local Group Photography Competition 2020 is “**British Wildlife**”. The theme is open to your personal interpretation but we are looking for beautiful images of British wild mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, invertebrates, plants or fungi. Images of domestic pets, farm animals and animals in captivity are not eligible.

The twelve images selected by the judges will appear in the Mid-Nene Calendar for 2021 sold in aid of the RSPB Mid-Nene Local Group to raise funds for RSPB conservation projects.

### How to Enter

1. Please read rules below.
2. Entrants may submit no more than **THREE** images. Entries must be in digital format. Prints cannot be accepted.
3. Entries can **only** be submitted via e-mail. No other means of entry will be accepted. Send your entry to [midnephoto@gmail.com](mailto:midnephoto@gmail.com).
4. Entries will only be accepted in .jpg format. The images should be clear and sharp as they will be printed at A4 size in the calendar. Successful entrants may be asked to submit higher resolution files for final judging.
5. Entrants should be aware that images in landscape format will be required for the calendar.
6. The email attaching the images should contain the following information:
  - a. Name of photographer
  - b. Title of each photograph. The title of each photo should ideally be the same as the digital image file name. If you do not know how to rename your images, please cross-reference the TITLE with the digital FILE NAME.
  - c. Details of each image submitted; species/subject and where taken.
7. All entries must be submitted by **31 January 2020**. Late entries will not be accepted.

### Rules

- Pictures must be taken in the United Kingdom.
- Amateur photographers only.
- Any RSPB employee or their immediate family will be ineligible to enter.
- No wildlife or habitats should be harmed, put at risk, or unduly disturbed in the process of taking photographs. Further guidance is available at: <http://www.rps.org/special-interest-groups/nature/about/the-nature-photographers-code-of-practice>
- Full copyright title remains with the owner. Please see full terms below regarding your entry and its potential use.
- If your entries contain **recognisable people**, you must obtain their written permission for their image to be entered into the competition using the attached Photography Permission Form.
- Entrants under 18 must have parental or legal guardian consent prior to entering the competition.
- The RSPB Mid-Nene Local Group accepts no responsibility for entries which are lost or corrupted during upload.
- Entries will be judged by members of the Mid-Nene Local Group at the indoor meeting held in the Saxon Hall, Raunds on the 19 March 2020.
- In the event of a chosen image being unsuitable for printing at A4 in the calendar, the competition organisers will select another image, from the runners up, to replace it.
- The Mid-Nene Local Group cannot judge any pictures whose details have been entered incorrectly.

- The competition organisers' decision on all matters affecting this competition is final and legally binding.
- No correspondence regarding the results will be entered into.
- Winning entrants will be notified by email and a list of the names of the winning entrants, along with the title of their winning submissions, will be posted on the RSPB Mid-Nene Local Group [website](#). By submitting an entry to the competition, you acknowledge and agree to being notified in this manner and a list of winners being posted on the website.

## Uses

The RSPB may retain your contribution and may choose to display your entry on a website. The RSPB may also publish your contribution in other media; where possible we will approach you directly to confirm your permission for publication. The RSPB reserves the right to remove contributions that it considers to be contrary to the spirit of the terms and conditions of submission, including submissions it considers to be objectionable or that violate copyright. The RSPB reserves the right to edit and alter submissions.

## Terms and Conditions

By submitting your contribution to the RSPB you agree to be legally bound by these terms and conditions.

Full copyright title shall be retained by the Author of any submissions. By submitting any contribution to the RSPB, you agree to grant the RSPB a perpetual royalty free licence to use any or all of the contributions in any of their publications, on the website and/or in any promotional material.
